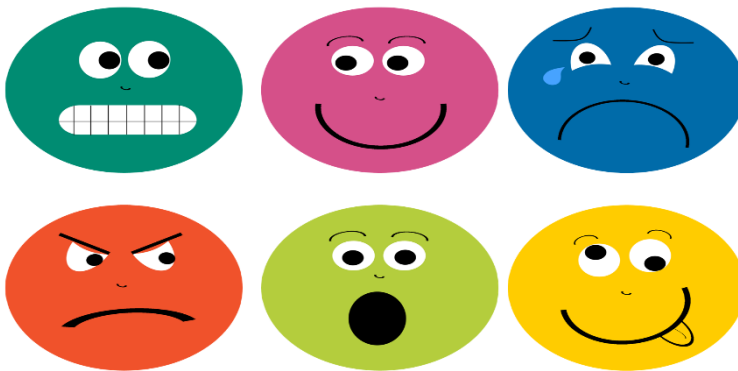

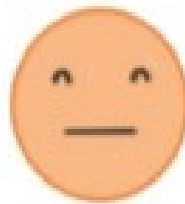

# English Live Lessons – Jake's first day!

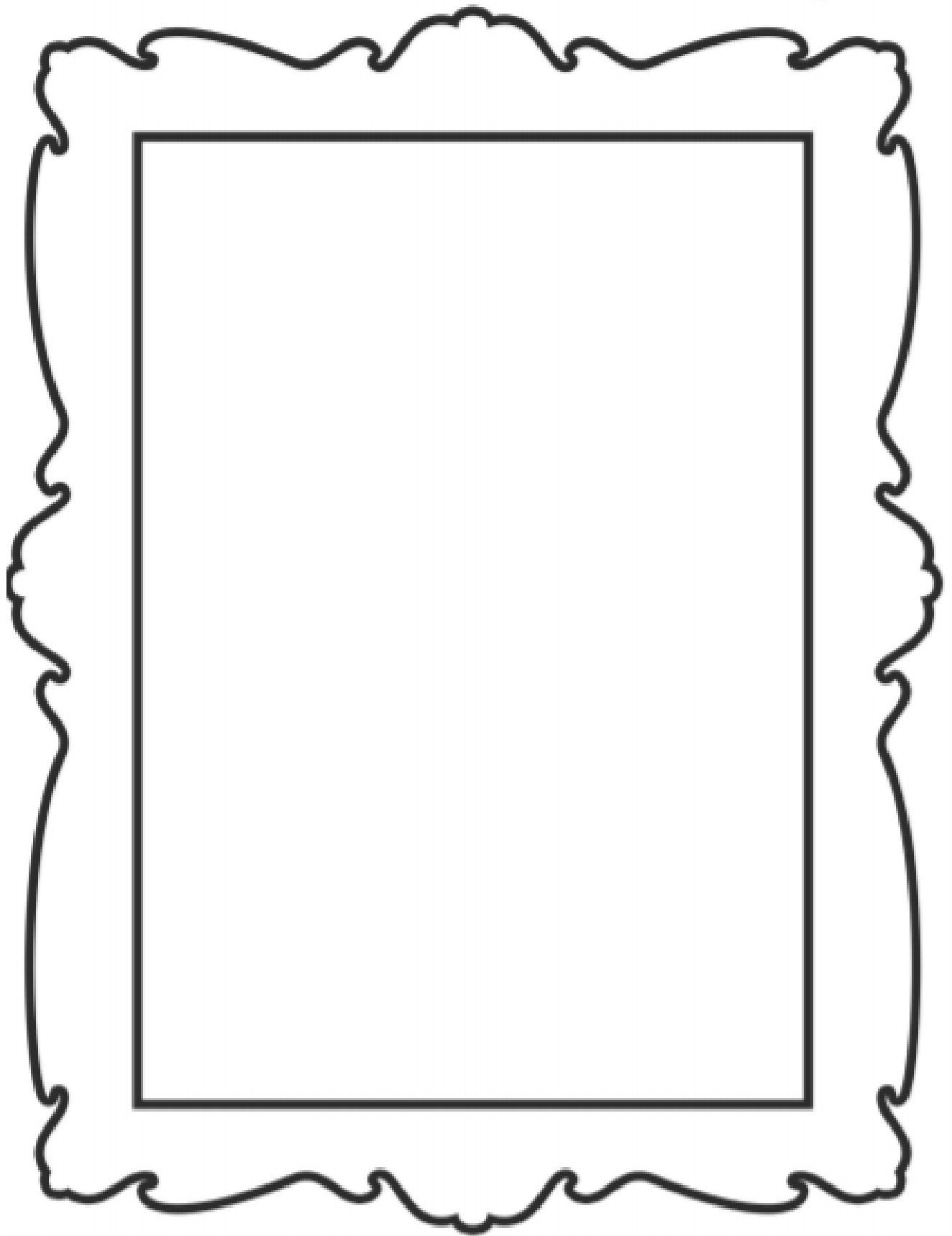

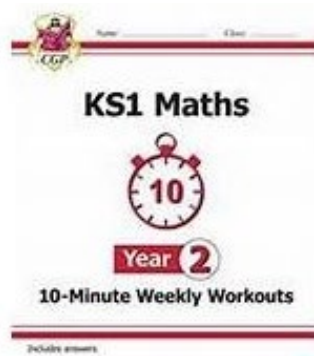
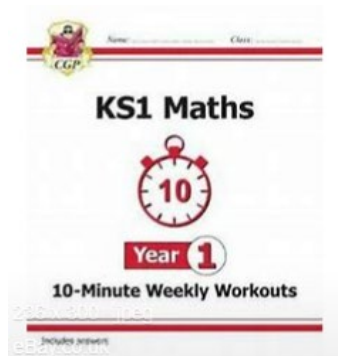


# Maths Live Lesson

**15 Guess the character!**

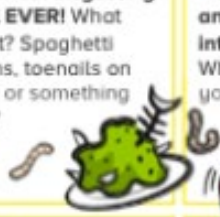
Think of a character from a book, write it down so no-one can see. Have others ask you questions to try and guess which character you chose.
