New Book Cover

LP to understand how persuasive writing helps to sell a product or service

In our live lesson today, we will look at different book cover designs. We will talk about the strategies used to capture the reader's attention and make us want to choose a book.

Then, listen to Mrs Cropper read you the story of *Brother Giovanni's Little Reward: How the Pretzel wasborn* (by Anna Egan Smucker). we will post a video of this to your class chat ready for this lesson.

While you listen consider the following questions:

+What do the pretzels symbolise?

+Why are they eaten at Lent?

+Why do you think many Christians pray each day during Lent?

Next, either follow the recipe below to make pretzels or recreate one using modelling clay, play dough or rope/ string.

Note: Pretzels are seen as a traditional Lenten food (to be eaten at Lent) by many people around the world. They are said to have been created by a monk in Germany around AD610 because the shape resembles someone crossing their arms in prayer. They were given as rewards to children who had memorised their prayers.

Recipe for soft Lenten pretzels



Ingredients:

250 ml warm water
1 tbsp yeast
2 tbsp brown sugar
2 tbsp white sugar
2 tsp salt
440 g flour
5 tsp bicarbonate of soda
1 egg
coarse salt (optional)



Method:

Makes around 12 pretzels



Caution - hot liquids!

1. Pour the water into a large bowl and stir in the yeast.
2. Add the salt, sugar and flour.
3. Mix the dough until it comes away from the side of the bowl.
4. Knead for two minutes on a floured surface.
5. Cut a slice from the dough, roll it into a rope and coil it into a pretzel shape.
6. Cover with cling film and leave to rise for 30 minutes.
7. Heat 1 litre of water in a frying pan and boil the pretzels for 1 minute on each side.
8. Beat 1 egg with 2 teaspoons of water and brush on the pretzels.
9. Sprinkle with coarse salt (optional).
10. Bake at 250 C or Gas mark 9 for 10 minutes.
